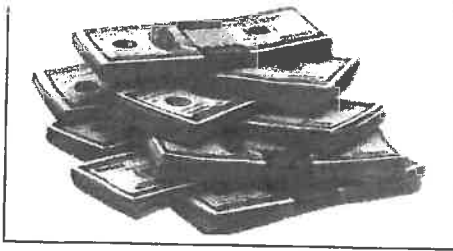


Integrated Public Alert and Warning System **Nationwide Test Oct. 3**

There will be a nationwide test of the Integrated Public Alert and Warning System (IPAWS) beginning at 1:18 p.m. on Oct. 3. The Federal Emergency Management Agency, in coordination with the Federal Communications Commission, will conduct a nationwide test of IPAWS and its Emergency Alert System (EAS) and Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA). This test message will be sent to cell phones that are connected to wireless providers participating in WEA.

Learning time will likely be disrupted, so national school safety partners, including the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Safe and Healthy Students, highly encourage districts to use the time to provide a teachable moment about emergency preparedness. Dear Parent,

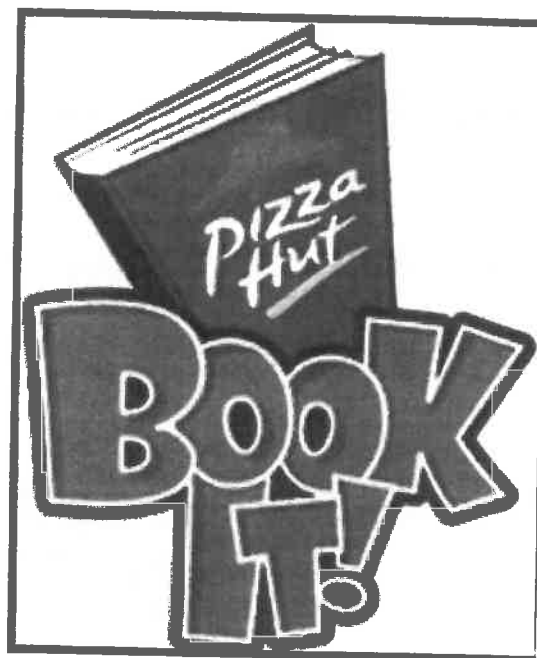
