

**GRAND RIDGE DISTRICT. #95
BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING**

December 14, 2021

The December regular monthly Grand Ridge School Board of Education meeting was called to order via remote by President Mike Wielgopalan, on Tuesday, December 14, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken. Answering present were: Rich Frye, Kayla Simons, George Lukach, John Lubelski, Mary Domoleczny and Kate Jaegle. Also present was Ted Sanders, Terry Ahearn and Melissa Bernard.

Visitors to the meeting were: Amanda Jaegle, Jon Woodyer, Dottie Groesch, Kylie Eike, Tara Bennett, Nick Domoleczny, Nikki Speirer and Lori Carbam

After the Pledge of Allegiance, a motion to approve the minutes of the November meetings was made by George Lukach. This was seconded by Mary Domoleczny. Voice vote taken: All Ayes. Motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved, to be placed on file for further audit with a motion made by Mary Domoleczny and seconded by John Lubelski. Voice vote taken. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills: The bills for the month of December were inspected and presented for payment. A motion was made to approve the bills by Rich Frye. This was seconded by Kayla Simons. Roll call vote was taken. All Ayes. Motion carried.

Public Comment: The following addressed the Board in public comment:

- Dottie Groesch wanted to know why the Christmas program was canceled with no explanation. Mr. Sanders shared that we were waiting on the Music Teacher to communicate with us, however we knew we needed to let parents know the program was canceled.
- Mr. Sanders introduced Kylie Eike and Tara Bennett to everyone, as they are new to our staff this year.
- Nick Domoleczny addressed the Board requesting that there needs to be an official statement to parents on the Girls Basketball Coach. Board President responded that this matter has been reviewed by the Board, it is a confidential matter and thanked him for his comments.

Principal Report:

- **December Calendar:** Mr. Ahearn shared with the Board the December calendar.

School Board Calendar for 2022: A motion to approve the 2022 Board Meeting dates was made by George Lukach. This was seconded by Rich Frye. Voice vote taken. All aye. Motion carried.

Superintendent's Report:

- **Holiday Gift Cards:** Mr. Sanders shared with the Board that the Holiday Gift Cards have been purchased.
- **Health Life Safety:** We will need to begin working on this process, as this is due in 2023. It was suggested that the Building Committee set up a meeting to go over the projects before meeting with Matt Lamps. A meeting will be set up after the first of the year.
- **Test to Stay Protocol:** A motion was made by Kayla Simons to adopt the Test to Stay Protocol. This was seconded by Mary Domoleczny. All Ayes; Kate Jaegle abstained. Motion carried.
- **Press Plus Policy Updates:** Mr. Sanders shared that the next Press Plus Policy updates that will be coming is very large and will need to have a committee to review these prior to a Board Meeting. John Lubelski and Mary Domoleczny volunteered to assist with these updates.
- **3rd/4th Grade Basketball:** Mr. Sanders shared that he received a request from Amanda Jaegle requesting to use the gym for practices for a 3rd and 4th grade girls basketball club. Mr. Sanders asked Amanda to explain to the Board, the program and what support she would need from the school. She explained that she would need a place to practice with the girls that were interested. It was agreed that she would need to fill out a facility usage request form, depending on when practices are, there may need to have a custodian present to open the building.

Executive Session - A motion was made at 7:59 p.m. by Jon Lubelski to move to closed session to discuss the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of specific employees, student discipline, and pending litigation. This was seconded by Kate Jaegle. Voice vote taken: All Aye. Motion carried.

The board returned to open session at 8:47 p.m. on a motion made by John Lubelski and seconded by George Lukach. Voice vote taken. All Aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Rich Frye to hire Kerri Sawin as the Assistant Girls Volleyball Coach. This was seconded by Kayla Simons. Voice vote taken. All ayes; Mary Domoleczny abstained. Motion carried.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Rich Frye. This was seconded by Kate Jaegle. Voice vote taken: All Ayes. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 8:48 p.m.
