

**GRAND RIDGE DISTRICT. #95
BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING**

June 8, 2021

The regular monthly Grand Ridge School Board of Education meeting was called to order in regular session by President Mike Wielgopalan, on Tuesday, June 8, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken. Answering present were: Michael Wielgopalan, Richard Frye, Mary Domoleczny, George Lukach, Kate Jaegle and John Lubelski. Also present was Ted Sanders, Terry Ahearn and Melissa Bernard. Absent Kayla Simons.

Visitors to the meeting: None

After the Pledge of Allegiance, a motion to approve the minutes of the May meeting was made by Mary Domoleczny. This was seconded by George Lukach. Voice vote taken: All Ayes. Motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved, to be placed on file for further audit with a motion made by Kate Jaegle and seconded by John Lubelski. Voice vote was taken: All Aye. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills. The bills for the month of May were inspected and presented for payment. A motion was made to approve the bills by Rich Frye. This was seconded by John Lubelski. Roll call vote was taken: All Aye. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Rich Frye to transfer \$18,541 from the Tort Fund to the Education Fund to cover a portion of supervisory salaries. This was seconded by Kate Jaegle. Roll call vote was taken. All Aye. Motion carried.

Final Budget Numbers for FY 21: Mr. Sanders shared with the Board the preliminary budget numbers for the fiscal year of 2021.

Consolidated District Plan: A motion was made by George Lukach to approve as presented the Consolidated District Plan. This was seconded by Mary Domoleczny. Voice vote taken. All ayes. Motion carried.

- Mr. Ahearn shared with the Board that summer school has started. This is being taught by Mrs. Cadegiani, with 4 students in attendance. This is a 5 week program being done by Google Meets.
- The Jump Start program for grades K-4 will begin in August, focusing on Math and Reading.
- Mr. Ahearn shared with the Board the plans for Algebra and Pre-Algebra for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Mr. Ahearn shared with the Board the new Apex program that will be taught for grades 6,7,8 for technology.

Superintendent Report:

- Mr. Sanders shared with the Board that we have received good feedback from the Graduation ceremony.
- A discussion was held in regards to looking into a Human Resource company to assist with HR matters. It was agreed that the personnel committee would look into options.
- Mr. Sanders shared that Dee Molinare from IASB will be coming to conduct additional board training. Mr. Sanders will check to see if the following dates will work for IASB July 26 & 27 and August 3rd.
- A discussion with the Board was held on the direction of sports and the numbers of students that are participating in these sports. It was agreed that a survey will be sent out to parents to see what the participation would be in grades 5,6,7,8 for the sports that are offered.
- A discussion was held on the non-certified staff increases. It was agreed that we will wait until we know how much of an increase the health insurance will have.

A motion to accept Paula Krohe's resignation as the Head Volleyball Coach was made by Mary Domoleczny. This was seconded by John Lubelski. Voice vote taken. All aye. Motion carried.

A motion to hire Lana Krohe as part time summer help was made by Kate Jaegle. This was seconded by George Lukach. Voice vote taken. All aye. Motion carried.

A motion to hire Jacob Krueger as part time summer help was made by Rich Frye. This was seconded by Kayla Simons. Voice vote taken. All aye. Motion carried.


