

**GRAND RIDGE DISTRICT. #95
BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING**

May 11, 2021

The regular monthly Grand Ridge School Board of Education meeting was called to order in regular session by President Mike Wielgopalan, on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken. Answering present were: Mary Domoleczny, George Lukach, Michael Wielgopalan, Kate Jaegle, Rich Frye, John Lubelski and Kayla Simons. Also present was Ted Sanders, Terry Ahearn and Melissa Bernard.

Visitors to the meeting: Lisa Killelea and Michele Doerr.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, a motion to approve the minutes from the April meetings was made by Rich Frye. This was seconded by Mary Domoleczny. Voice vote taken: All Ayes. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved, to be placed on file for further audit with a motion made by George Lukach and seconded by Kayla Simons. Voice vote was taken: All Ayes. Motion carried.

Payment of Bills: The bills for the month of April were inspected and presented for payment. A motion was made to approve the bills by Rich Frye. This was seconded by Kate Jaegle. Roll call vote was taken: All Aye. Motion carried.

A motion to transfer \$616.31 from the Operations and Maintenance Fund to Debt Services to cover the deficit balance in that account made by Rich Frye. This was seconded by George Lukach. Roll call vote was taken. All Ayes. Motion carried.

PRINCIPAL REPORT

- **Attendance:** Mr. Ahearn gave a brief overview of the attendance report for the month of April
- **Discipline:** Mr. Ahearn gave a brief overview of the April discipline report.
- **Calendar:** Mr. Ahearn shared with the Board the calendar for the month of May.
- **Reopening Plan:** Mr. Ahearn shared with the Board the plans for reopening back to in person learning. Students will report back to in person learning on May 17th; with 11:50 a.m. dismissal. All students will need to report back to in person learning with the exception of students needing to be quarantined. If students are going to remain on remote learning, we will need Dr. documentation to continue on remote learning. All Board members agreed to the reopening plan.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- **Board Training:** Mr. Sanders shared that Kayla Simons, John Lubelski, Kate Jaegle attended the PERA training.
- **2020-2021 Final Calendar:** Mr. Sanders shared with the Board the final calendar for 2020-2021 school year. All students will be done on June 1st with a remote planning day for teachers on June 2nd. June 3rd will be a Teachers Institute. Summer hours in the office will begin on June 4th
- **Non-certified salary list for 2021-2022:** Mr. Sanders shared with the Board the list of salaries for all non-certified salary staff.
- **Co-Op with Deer Park:** A discussion was held on looking into the Co-op agreements with Baseball, Softball, and possibly Girls Basketball depending on numbers. A motion was made to proceed with a 2 year Co-Op agreement with Deer Park for Baseball and Softball by George Lukach. This was seconded by Mary Domoleczny. Voice vote taken. All Ayes. Motion carried.
- **Graduation:** Mr. Sanders shared with the Board the plans for graduation. It is set for June 2nd with a rain date of June 9th. The ceremony will be held outside in the courtyard.
- **Staff:** Mr. Sanders shared that we will be saying goodbye to Elizabeth Bernardoni, Rachel Berg, Amanda Gwin and Samantha Thompson; he thanked all of them for all of their hard work.
- **Building Updates:** Mr. Sanders updated the Board on the electrical updates and window project.

Executive Session: A motion was made at 8:34 p.m. by Kate Jaegle to move to a closed session to discuss the appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance or dismissal of specific employees, student discipline and pending litigation. This was seconded by Rich Frye. Voice vote taken: All Ayes. Motion carried.

The next regular meeting of the Grand Ridge School Board of Education will be held on Tuesday, June 8, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.


